**The differences between the sexes
in the psychoanalytic clinic of today**

What is the topicality of the relation of men and women with sex? The reference to its topicality leads us to interrogate the semblants that in our times cover the links of love, desire and jouissance between the sexual partners, whether they are hetero- or homosexual. It is a fact that our era has produced new semblants. Our aim will be to shed light on them on the basis of what the analytic experience teaches us, and to thus answer some fundamental questions that Lacan's teaching poses: what is the real of sex and what is it that in an analysis changes concerning the relation with sex? In our pursuit we shall meet the stumbling blocks that constitute the clinical differences between the sexes and the possible choices for the subject.

Dr Luis Izcovich is a psychiatrist and psychoanalyst, and a founding member of the International School of Psychoanalysis of the Forums of the Lacanian Field. He teaches at the Collège de Clinique Psychanalytique de Paris and practices psychoanalysis in Paris. He has published *Les paranoïaques et la psychanalyse*, Éditions Stilus, Paris, 2017, and *Les marques d'une psychanalyse*, Éditions Stilus, Paris, 2015 (in English, *The marks of a psychoanalysis*, trans. E. Faye and S. Schwartz, Karnac Books, London, 2017). He is the director of Éditions Stilus.

Dr Anita Izcovich is a psychoanalyst and a member of the International School of Psychoanalysis of the Forums of the Lacanian Field. She teaches at the Collège de Clinique Psychanalytique de Paris and practices psychoanalysis in Paris. She has published *Le corps précieux*, Éditions du Champ Lacanien, Paris, 2003; *Des sciences à la psychanalyse*, L'Harmattan, Paris, 2007; *Le femme, la lettre et l'image*, Éditions Stilus, Paris, 2016; and *La malédiction sur le sexe*, Éditions Stilus, Paris, 2017.
